Beginning from
June 1, 2019

**Failing to report carrying animal products
could result in a fines of up to 10 million KRW**

⦿ **Pork and related livestock products from countries
affected by African Swine Fever**

• 5 million (1st) → 7.5 million (2nd) → 10 million (3rd)

⦿ **Others**

• 1 million (1st) → 3 million (2nd) → 5 million (3rd)

Items subject to Quarantine (Restricted Items)



- **Animals** : Dogs, cats, birds, etc.
- **Livestock Products** : Beef, pork, chicken, duck, sausage, ham, beef jerky, canned meat, boiled meat, milk, beef tallow processed products (curry), etc.
- **Animal Products** : Antlers, bones, feathers, etc.
- **Dairy Products** : Milk, cheese, butter, etc.
- **Egg and Egg Products** : Chicken eggs, bird eggs, egg whites, egg powder, etc.
- **Pet Food, Snacks, Vitamins, etc.**
